1. What is Storage?

- Computer storage devices are hardware components that can store, port, or extract data files.
- They are essential for the functioning of a computer system, as they allow it to run programs, store information, and access data

2. Types of Storage

There are two types of storage devices used with computers:

Primary storage device, such as **RAM** (random-access memory),

and **Secondary** storage device, such as a **hard drive**

RAM is temporary Storage (whilst using or shortly thereafter)

Hard Drives, etc Can be permanent – until deleted or overwritten

We will concentrate today on **Secondary Storage**

Internal/External Hard Drive

NAS (Network Attached Storage)

USB Stick (flash Drive)

DVD / CD

Floppy Drives

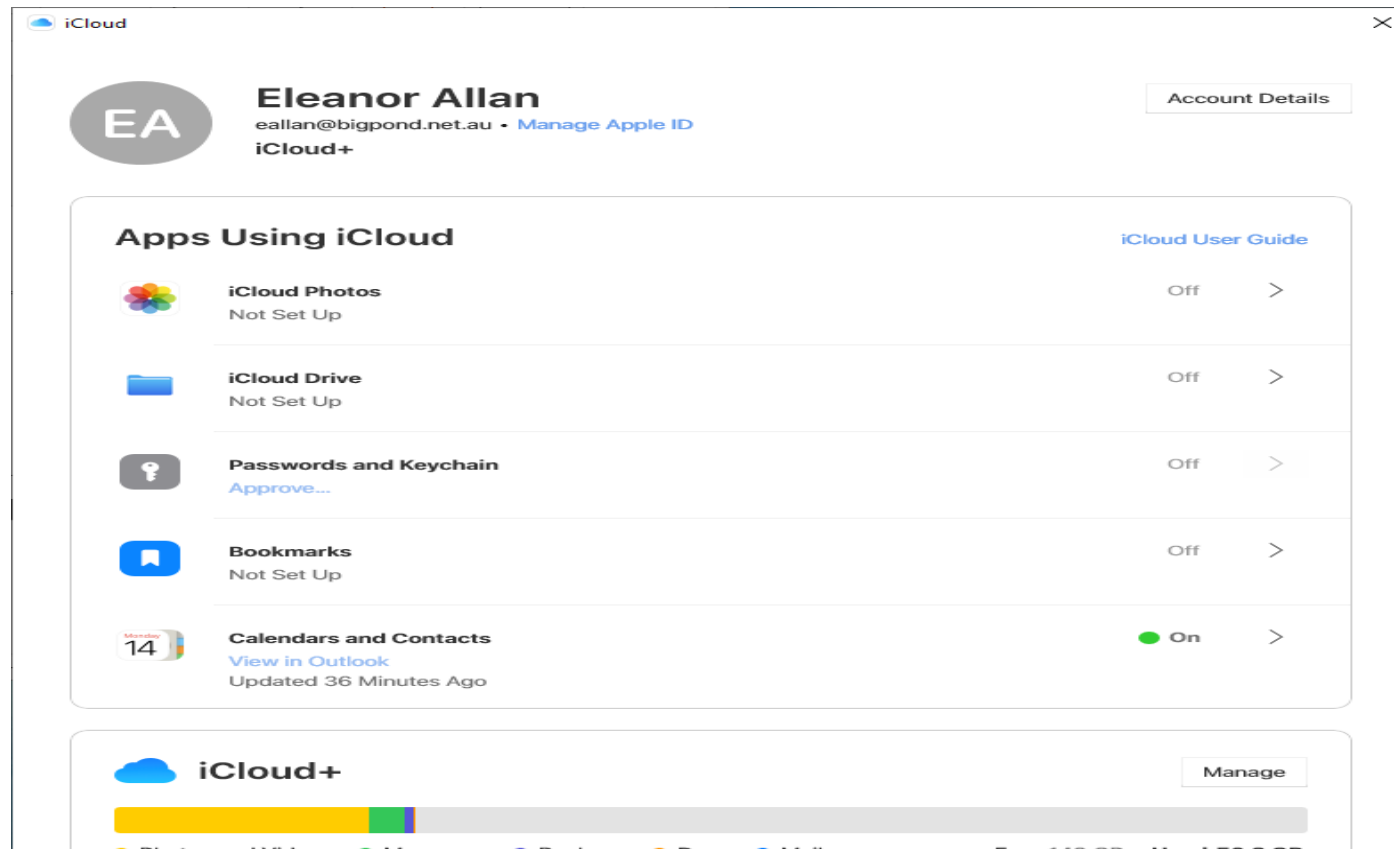


