Battery Life If not connected to Power Supply

3. Decide Hardware

Desktop Requires more Space but Larger Hard Disk Capacity, Lack of mobility

All-in-One Saves Space on Desk, 'Large Laptop', Can have High End Disk/Memory,

Laptop Smaller Screen but can add Monitor, Some very cheap models, some

expensive

2 in One Look and Feel of Tablet

Tablet Very mobile

Smartphone Most Mobile, Now Great Cameras, Phone

4. Choose Operating Environment

Windows Watch Win 10 Support.

Should be Win 11 or Upgrade Available Free

Mac / IOS Compatibility between devices and Family / Friends

Android

Other Linux, Unix, etc

5. Choose Key Components

Computer / All-In-One / Laptop / 2 in One

Processor (GHz – Gigahertz) (Intel, AMD)

RAM Random Access Memory – GB – Gigabytes

Hard Drive (HDD) or Solid State Drive (SSD)

Mirrored Drives Not Quite Backup

Storage Capacity GB – Gigabytes

NOTE: Higher End = Higher Price
