- **Password & Logon List**

- **Holiday & Accommodation - Itinerary Tour, Cruise, etc**
- **Travel Insurance**
- **Other Personal or travel related info eg Email list**

# Storing your documents on your device

- Before storing any of the Documents, -  
Decide where to Store them and Create a location which –  
YOU CAN LATER FIND EASILY

Most Documents are delivered as **Attachments** in an email

Others may need to be:

**Photographed** or **scanned** directly to its selected location

Some documents are **Downloaded** to your device

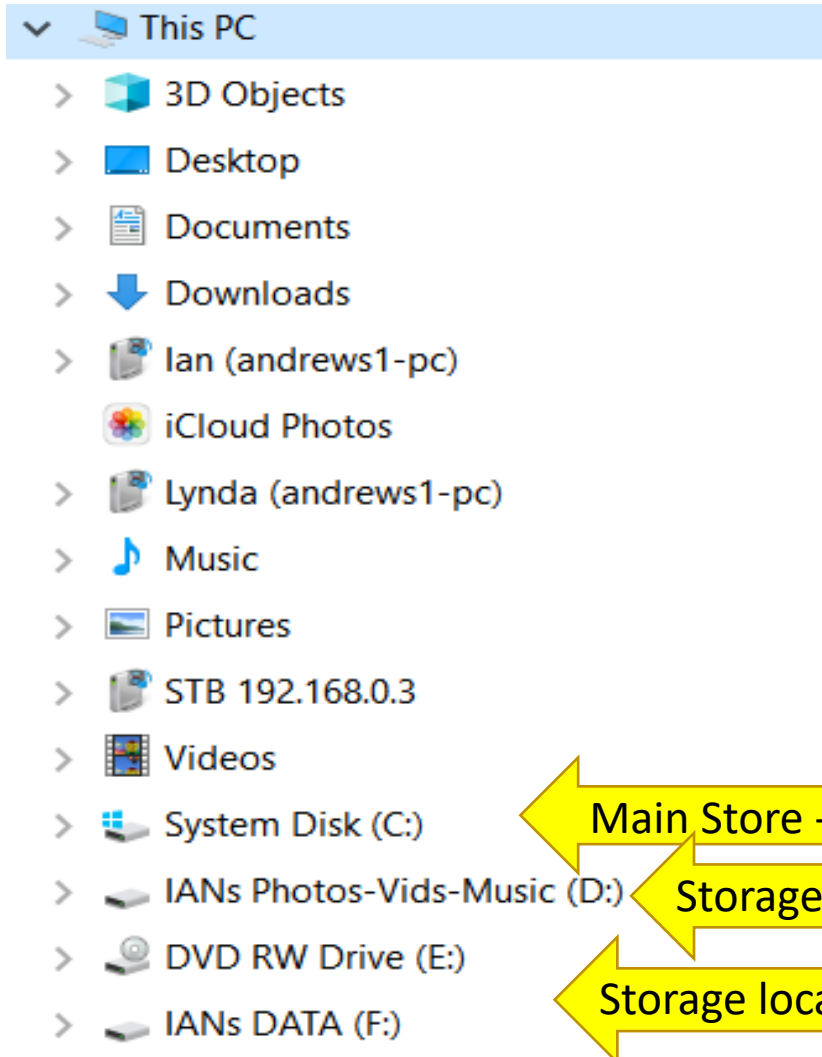
- All Documents need to be saved on your device in the selected location

# Typical Travel Documents

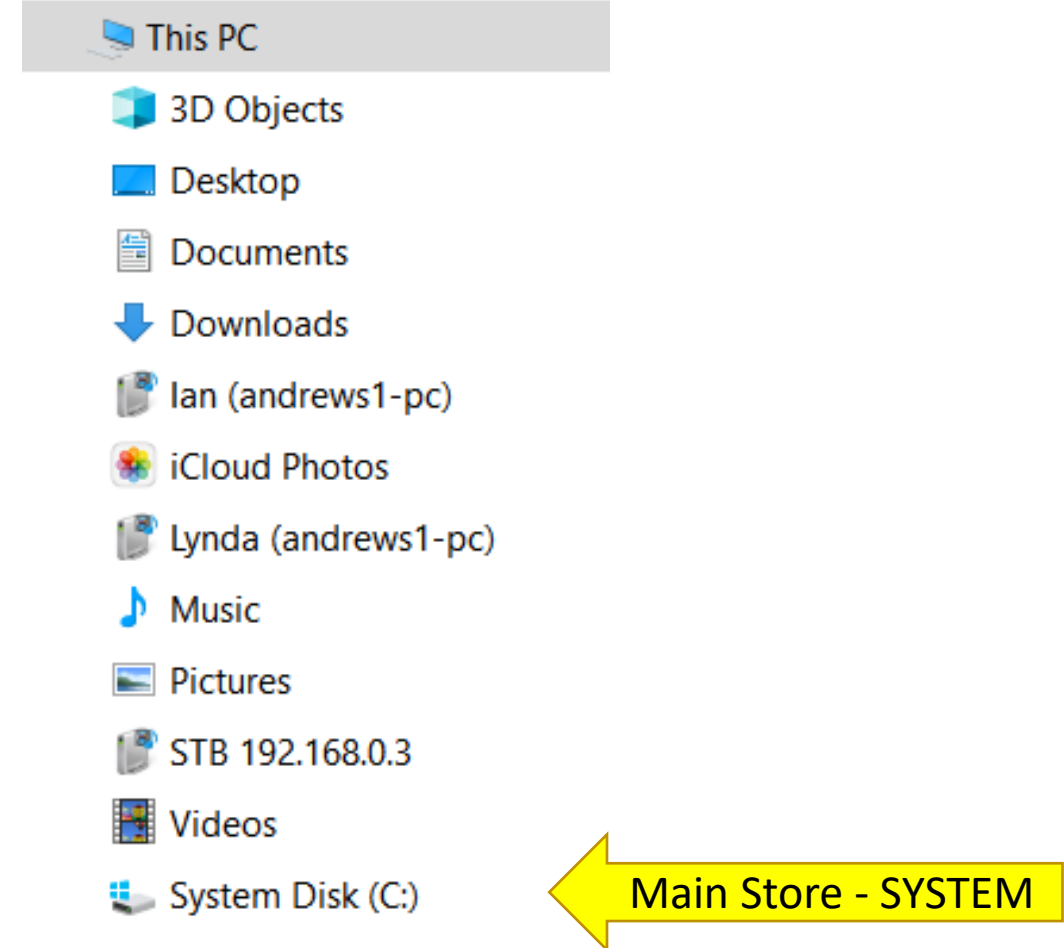
- **Passport** - photograph or scan
- **Visas** - email attachment **NOTE: refer Note 1 Digital Visa**
- **Driving Licence** - photograph or scan : **Note: both sides**
- **Medication Info incl COVID Cert etc** - scan doc directly to location
- **Bank Account & Credit Card details ie details** - photo or scan
- **Password & Logon List** - scan document
- **Flight Itinerary** - save a copy directly to its location
- **Holiday & Accommodation - Itinerary Tour, Cruise, etc** - save a copy
- **Travel Insurance** - save a copy
- **Other Personal or travel related info eg Email list, Birth/Marriage certificates.**

# Storing files on a Desktop and Laptop eg Windows

- **Desktop** Storage options



- **Laptop** Storage options (single only)



# Storage on different devices

## Laptop

- Laptop ( eg Windows 10 )

For **Non-Secure** Storage –

- 1 Create a Folder under the existing Folder “Documents” and call it eg **MY TRAVELS**

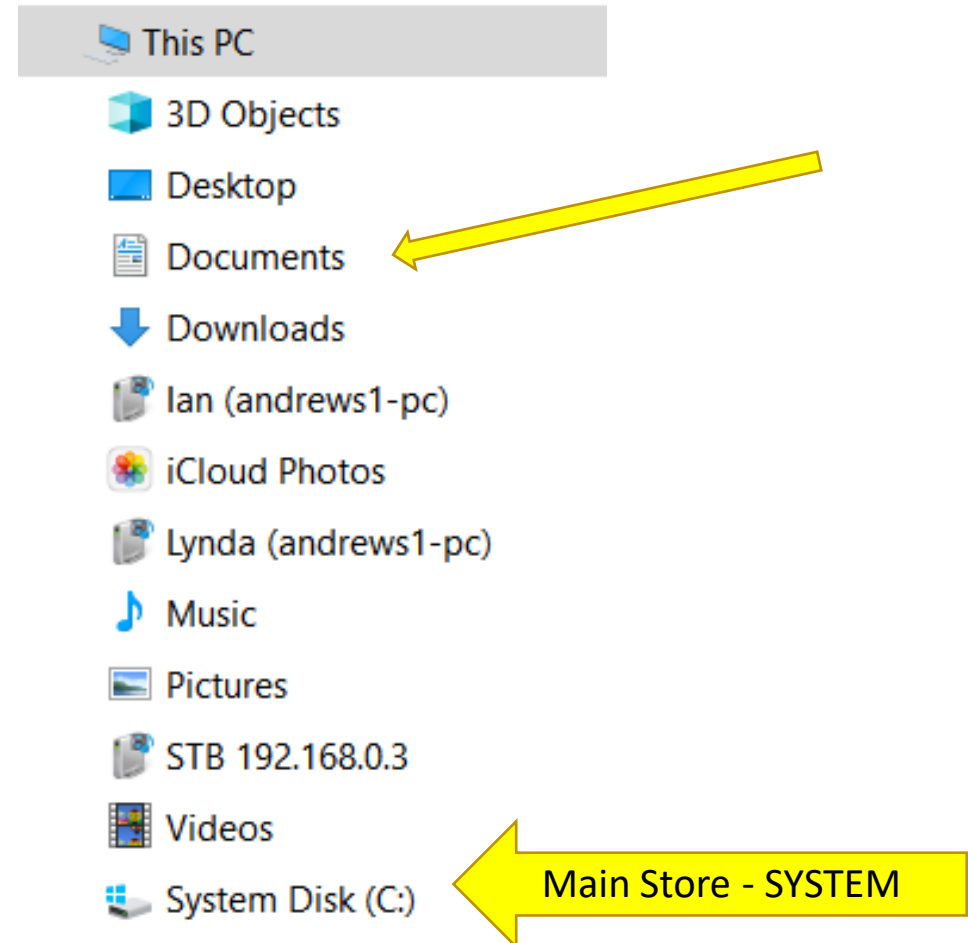
- 2 Copy all Travel docs to this folder.

For **Secure** Storage

**Password Protect Folder** “My Travels”

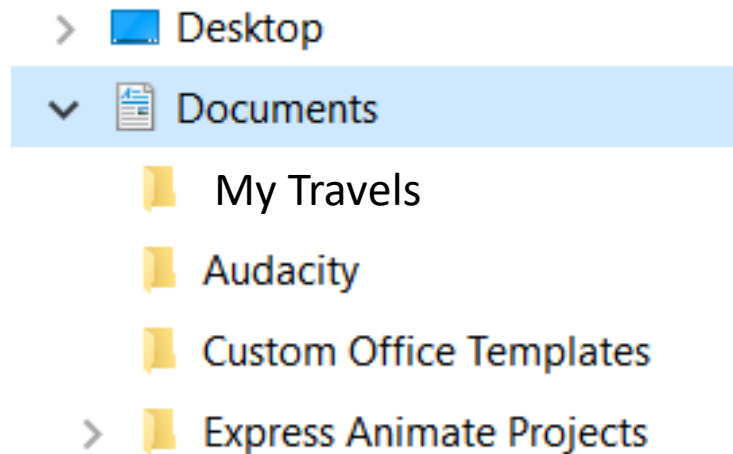
NOTE: There are several methods of Protecting files placed in a Folder

Display using File Explorer On Desktop or Laptop

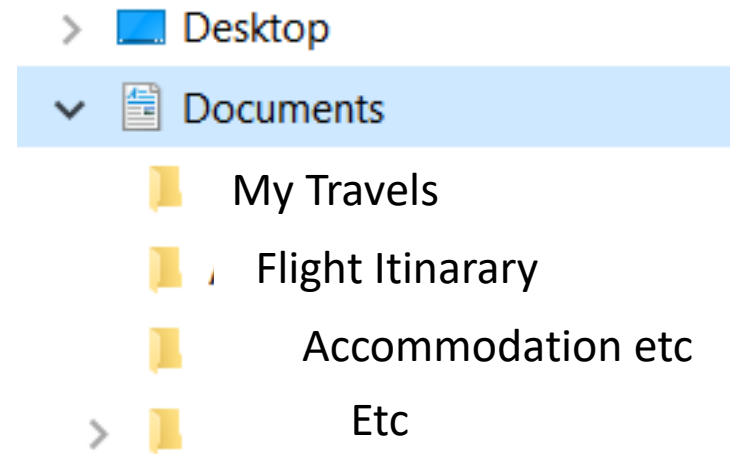


# Example of Stored Travel Files

# Store Files on other devices

## IPad - Mobile

- On a Mobile, Files are stored in “Internal” memory.
- New Folders eg ( My Travels) can be created under this Folder
- **Mobiles** Note that mobiles also store files in internal memory and under several different categories as listed below
- Images
- Videos
- Audio Files
- Documents
- Downloads
- Installation Files

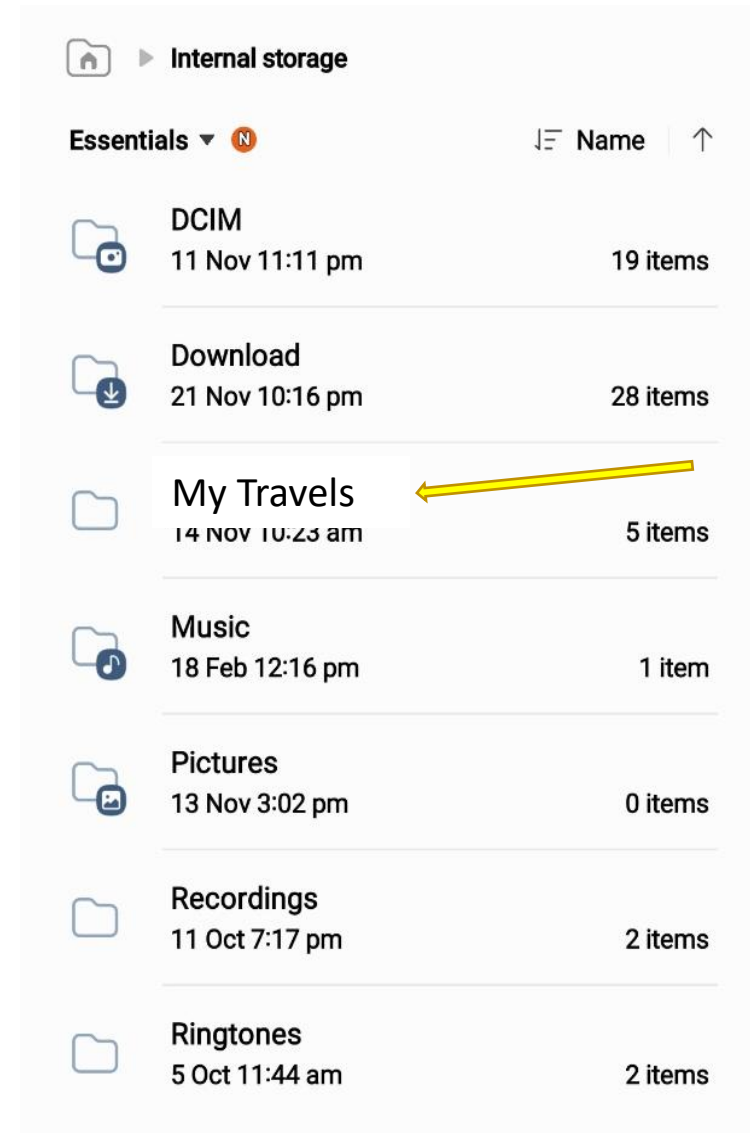
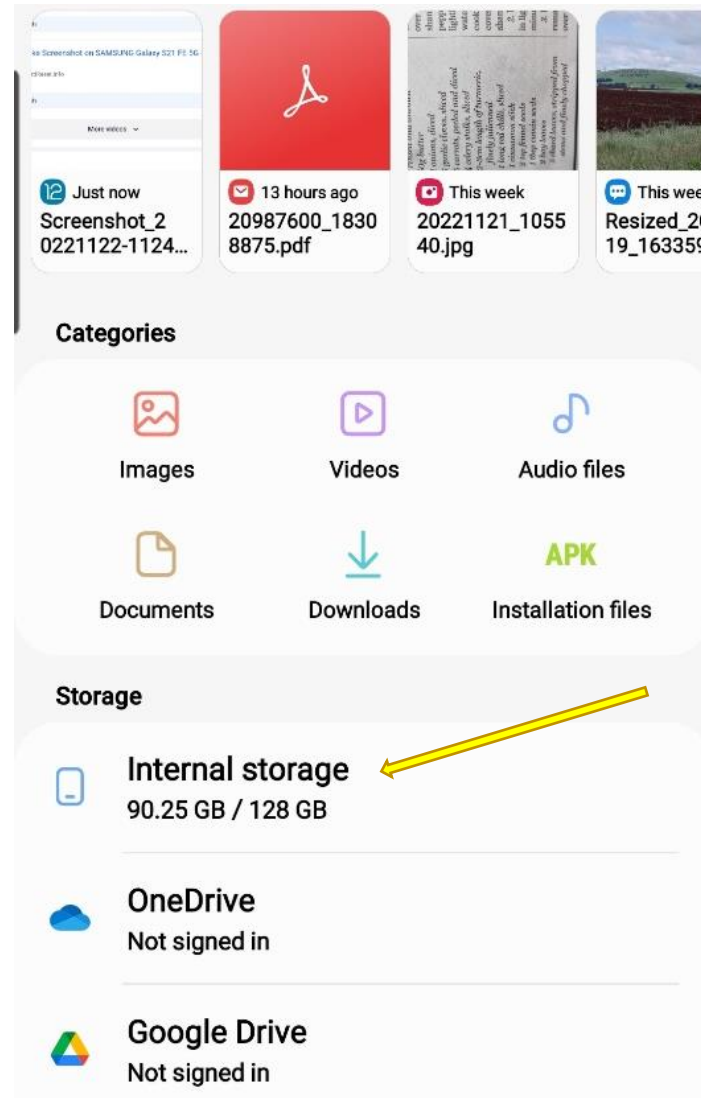
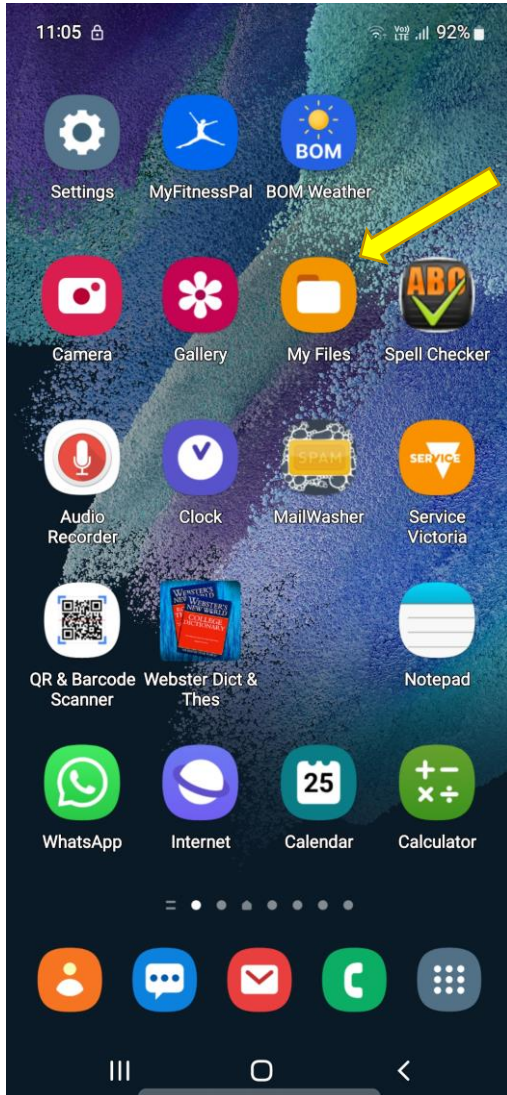
For Non-Secure Storage –

- 1 Create a Folder under “Internal” memory and call it eg MY TRAVELS
- 2 Copy all Travel docs to this folder.

, For Documents requiring Secure Storage

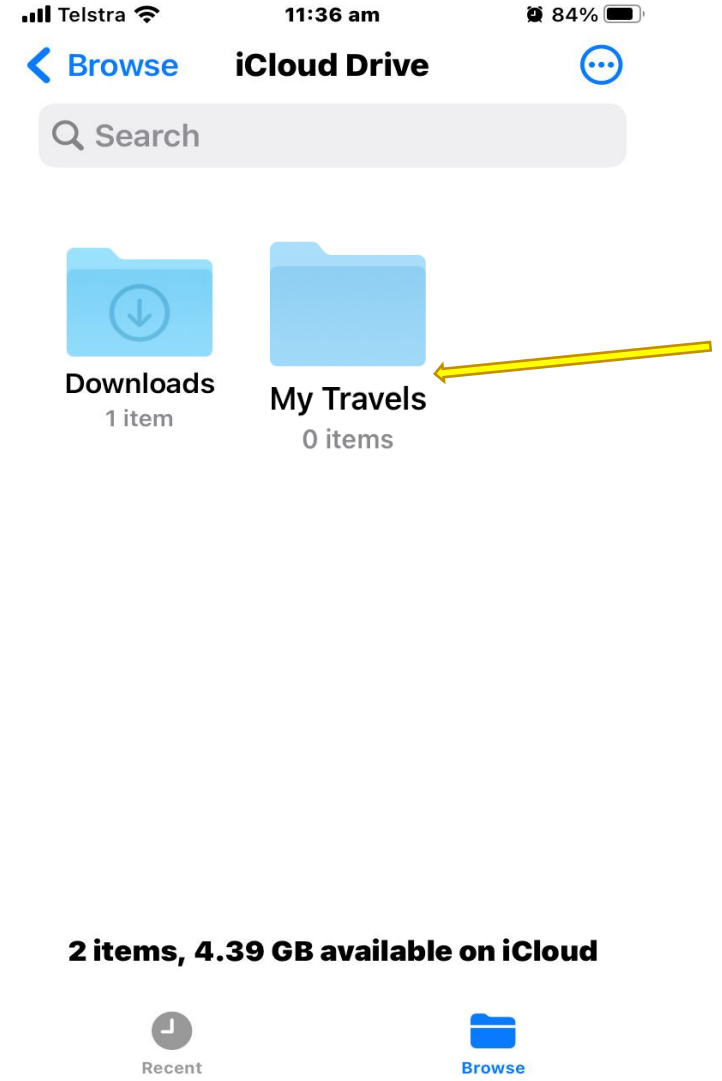
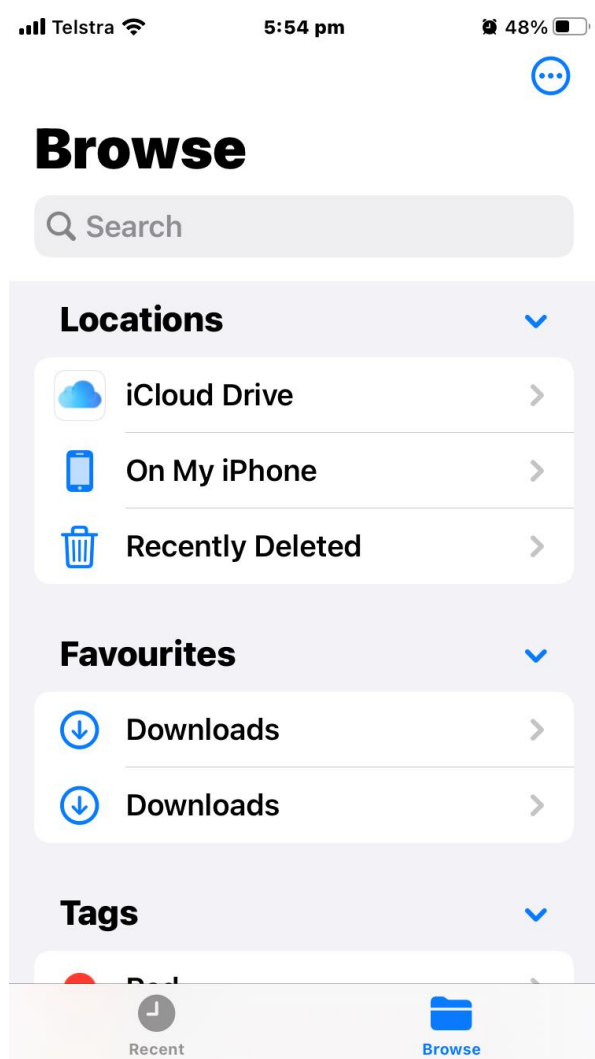
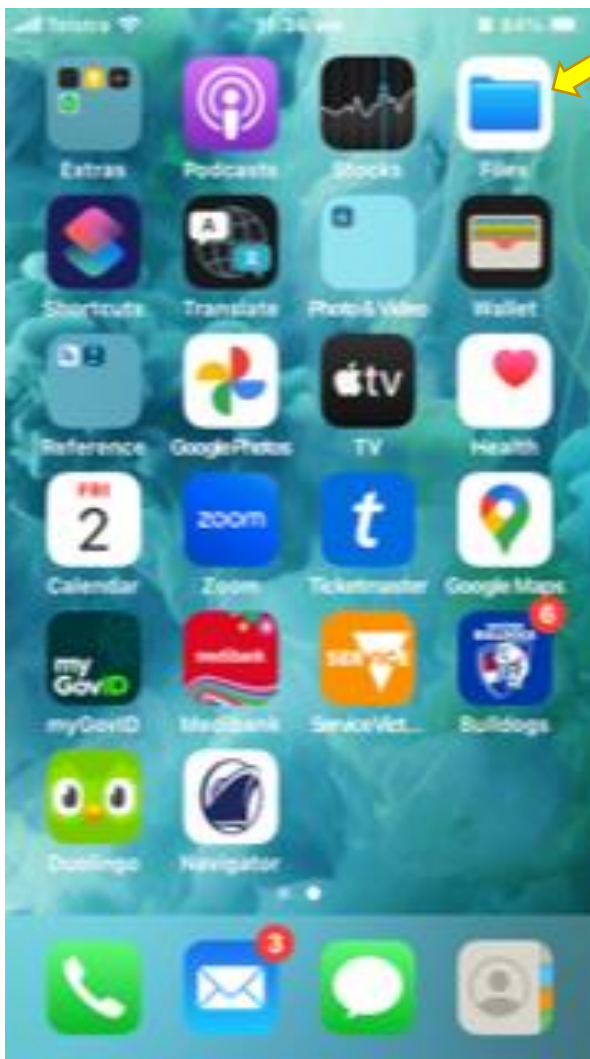
Store them either for Iphones to - **WALLET** or for Samaung’s to the **SECURE FOLDER**.

# Related information

- **Saving Files in iPhone**
  - **Save Files to the Files App on Your iPhone**
  - When you want to save an item to the Files App, tap the Share icon (which looks like a box with an arrow on top).
  - This opens the Share tab, next select **Save to Files**. You may have to tap the More icon (which has three dots on it) to select Save to Files
  - If you tap **On This iPhone**, you'll only be able to save the files to any folders already available
  - Use the icon tab to create "**My Travel**
  - Now you can save notes, documents, and photos to this folder.
- **Download Int Covid Certificate**
  - 1. Sign in to your myGov account using a browser on your device.
  - 2. Select **Medicare**.
  - 3. Select **View proof** in Proof of vaccinations.
  - 4. Select **Request a certificate**.
  - 5. Select your **name**, then **Next**.
  - 6. Follow the steps to verify your vaccinations and passport details.
  - 7. Select either **Add to Apple Wallet** or **Save to phone**


- NOTE 1 Digital Visas –
- Some types of Visas do not have a physical presence, ie they are imbedded in a Passport and are not visible. To view the visa details, it is necessary to check online and locate the application VEVO
- (Visa Entitlement Verification Online system )
- VEVO is used to [check your visa details and conditions](#). Use VEVO to send proof of your visa conditions to others, for example, employers, landlords or the government of a country you would like to visit

# Online forms, Checkin apps uploads & Downloads

- Online Forms - Forms usually contain spaces into which you can either type text or select an answer from a choice of options.

## Text boxes

A text box is a blank field where you type details like your name, address, or password.



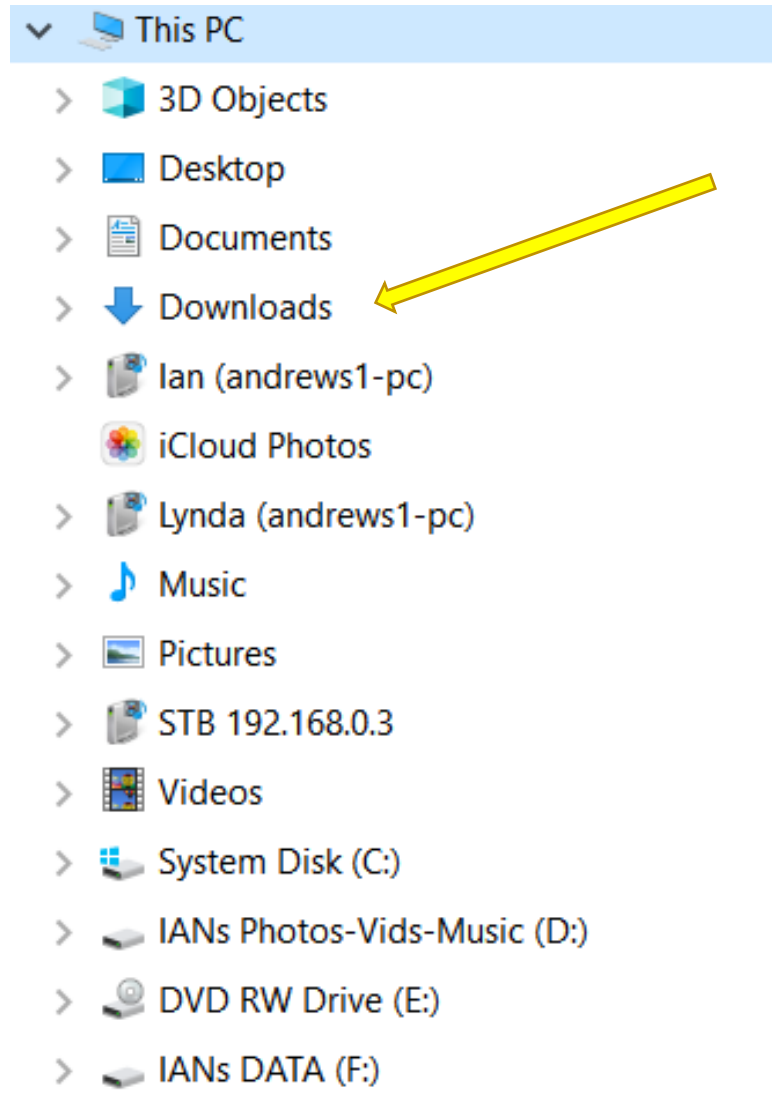

## Copying vs. Uploading

Many new computer users inappropriately refer to [copying](#) or [moving](#) files as uploading. When copying a file from your computer to another drive or folder on the same computer, you're copying that file and not uploading the file. If you're sending a file to a *different* computer from your computer, you're uploading the file.



# Freehand Entry

If the Text required is long, ie more than 10 words, its better to write it as a note or small Word file and save it temporarily then copy / paste it into the area on the form where it is required.

# Signatures

It is very difficult to sign ones name online, better to either simply use three initials or copy and paste a pre written Signature which has be scanned and saved in a Secure Folder.
